MANDIRI BIDAN MURTINAWITA KOTA PEKANBARU TAHUN 2020

ABSTRAK

Asuhan kebidanan komprehensif merupakan asuhan kebidanan yang diberikan secara menyeluruh dimulai dari ibu hamil, bersalin, nifas, neonatus dan keluarga berencana. Studi kasus ini bertujuan untuk memberikan asuhan kebidanan yang menyeluruh dan berkesinambungan sejak ibu hamil trimester III, bersalin, nifas dan neonatus. Asuhan kebidanan ini dilakukan di PMB Murtinawita dan dilanjutkan dengan kunjungan rumah Ny.T dimulai pada bulan November 2019 sampai dengan bulan Januari 2020 dengan kunjungan hamil 3 kali, persalinan 1 kali, nifas 3 kali, dan neonatus 3 kali. Pada Ny.T proses kehamilan berlangsung fisiologis meskipun terdapat keluhan seperti puting susu sedikit menonjol, tetapi hal tersebut dapat diatasi dengan memberikan pendidikan kesehatan diantaranya, senam hamil dan perawatan payudara. Proses persalinan berjalan normal di PMB Murtinawita, pada tanggal 26 Desember 2019 pukul 01:20 WIB, bayi Ny.T lahir dengan jenis kelamin laki-laki, menangis kuat, bergerak aktif, berat badan 3500 gram, dan panjang badan 51 cm. pada masa nifas ibu mengeluh ASI kurang lancar, puting susu lecet, tetapi keluhan tersebut dapat teratasi dengan pendidikan kesehatan berupa fisiologi laktasi dan perawatan payudara. Diharapkan profesi bidan dalam memberikan asuhan kebidanan berkelanjutan (CoMC). Selain itu, memperhatikan dan meningkatkan kompetensi dalam memberikan asuhan kebidanan sesuai dengan standar pelayanan kebidanan.

ABSTRACT

Comprehensive midwifery care is the care provided thoroughly starting from pregnancy, labor, postpartum, neonatal period, to family planning. This case study aimed to provide comprehensive and continuous midwifery care since the third trimester of pregnancy, labor, postpartum, and neonatal period. Midwifery care was carried out at PMB Murtinawita and continued with a visit to Mrs. N's house starting in November 2019 until January 2020 with 3 pregnancy visits, 1 labor visit, 3 postpartum visits, and 3 neonatal visits. Mrs. T's pregnancy process ran well physiologically although there were several complaints of discomfort such a retracted nipple problem but this could be overcome by providing continuous health education and breast care. The labor process was normal at PMB Murtinawita. On December 26, 2019 at 01.20, Mrs. T's baby was born with male sex, cried strongly, moved actively, weighed 3500 grams, and was 51 cm in body length. During the postpartum period, Mrs. T complained that milk was not produced well and nipples blisters complain, but the complain could be overcome with health education in the form of lactation physiology and breast care. It is expected that midwives should provide continuity of midwifery care (CoMC). In addition, midwives should pay attention to improve competence in providing midwifery care in accordance with midwifery service standards.
