ABSTRACT

Comprehensive midwifery care is a comprehensive midwifery care, Especially in maternal and child health, this Final Assignment Report aims to provide comprehensive and continuous midwifery care since the third trimester of pregnancy, childbirth, post-partum and family planning and neonates. Midwifery care is carried out in an independent midwife practice and resumed Mrs. Ny's home visit. N, starting in December 2019 until February 2020, there were 10 visits, namely 3 times of pregnancy, 1 time of delivery, 3 times of childbirth, 3 times of neonates. In Ny.N the process of pregnancy goes on physiologically although there are some complaints of discomfort with lower abdominal pain, low back pain and frequent urination and this can be overcome by providing continuing health education. The delivery process is proceeding normally in the Independent Midwife Practices. Spontaneous birth babies with female sex, body weight 3800 grams, and body length of 50 cm. During childbirth the mother complained about her milk coming out a little and the stomach feels mules, after being given health education, how to increase breast milk, breastfeeding continues. During the neonatal period, the baby's body weight increases by 2 kg on day 6. This is due to the process of breastfeeding that is good and right. It is expected that midwifery service providers will always maintain existing midwifery services. It is expected that midwifery service providers who are carrying out practices to always maintain existing midwifery services, It is expected that case reports that have been carried out can add to the source of insight into student knowledge in the Polytechnic of the Ministry of Health, Riau, Department of Midwifery.
