**ASUHAN KEBIDANAN KOMPREHENSIF PADA NY.Y DI PMB ROSITA  
PEKANBARU**

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**ABSTRAK**

Kementerian Kesehatan mengusung program yang disebut sebagai transformasi Kesehatan yang terdiri dari 6 pilar yang salah satunya adalah transformasi layanan primer yang mencakup upaya promotif dan preventif. Studi kasus ini bertujuan untuk memberikan asuhan kebidanan yang komprehensif dan berkesinambungan pada Ny.Y G<sub>5</sub>P<sub>3</sub>A<sub>1</sub>H<sub>3</sub> dari masa hamil trimester III, bersalin, nifas, dan neonatus di PMB Rosita Kota Pekanbaru. Asuhan yang diberikan sesuai dengan standar kebidanan dan dengan metode pendokumentasian SOAP. Asuhan kebidanan diberikan pada kontak pertama pada usia kehamilan 36-37 minggu mulai dari Oktober 2024 sampai dengan Juni 2025, yaitu 3 kali pada saat hamil, 1 kali pada saat mendampingi proses persalinan, 4 kali pada saat nifas, dan 4 kali saat neonatus. Keluhan yang dialami Ny. Y pada saat kehamilan yaitu sering BAK, Asuhan yang di berikan sesuai kebutuhan dan masalah dapat di atasi. Persalinan dilakukan dengan pemberian oksitosin drip karena kontraksi uterus tidak adekuat untuk mendukung kemajuan persalinan. Proses persalinan selanjutnya dilakukan sesuai dengan Standar Asuhan Persalinan Normal (APN). Bayi lahir spontan, berat badan (BB) 3100 gram dan panjang badan (PB) 49 cm. Pada masa nifas asuhan yang diberikan yaitu pijat oksitosin, pijat laktasi, senam nifas, dan *Skrining Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale* (EPDS) normal. Pada neonatus dilakukan perawatan tali pusat, dan pijat bayi. Setelah dilakukan pijat bayi terjadi peningkatan berat badan sebesar 900 gram pada hari ke 28. Bidan diharapkan mampu untuk mengaplikasikan asuhan yang telah diberikan sesuai dengan kebutuhan pasien berdasarkan evidence based.

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**ABSTRACT**

*The Ministry of Health carries out a program called Health transformation consisting of 6 pillars, one of which is the transformation of primary services that include promotive and preventive efforts. This case study aims to provide comprehensive and continuous midwifery care to Mrs. Y G5P3A1H3 from the third trimester of pregnancy, childbirth, postpartum, and neonate at PMB Rosita Pekanbaru City. The care provided is in accordance with midwifery standards and with the SOAP documentation method. Midwifery care is provided at the first contact at 36-37 weeks of gestation starting from October 2024 to June 2025, namely 3 times during pregnancy, 1 time when accompanying the labor process, 4 times during postpartum, and 4 times as a neonate. The complaint experienced by Mrs. Y during pregnancy was frequent urination, the care provided was according to needs and the problem could be overcome. Delivery was carried out by administering oxytocin drip because uterine contractions were inadequate to support the progress of labor. The subsequent delivery process was carried out in accordance with the Normal Delivery Care Standards (APN). The baby was born spontaneously, weighing (BB) 3100 grams and body length (PB) 49 cm. During the postpartum period, the care provided was oxytocin massage, lactation massage, postpartum gymnastics, and normal Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale (EPDS) Screening. In neonates, umbilical cord care and baby massage were carried out. After the baby massage, there was an increase in body weight of 900 grams on the 28th day. Midwives are expected to be able to apply the care that has been given according to the patient's needs based on evidence based.*
