ABSTRAK

Bidan merupakan tenaga kesehatan lini terdepan dalam memberikan pelayanan kesehatan ibu dan anak (KIA) yang dituntut memiliki kompetensi tinggi serta mampu memberikan pelayanan yang menyeluruh dan berkelanjutan. Salah satu pendekatan yang mendukung hal ini adalah model Continuity of Midwifery Care (CoMC), yaitu asuhan kebidanan yang berkesinambungan dari masa kehamilan, persalinan, nifas, bayi baru lahir, hingga pelayanan keluarga berencana. Asuhan secara menyeluruh dan berkesinambungan pada Ny.R G3P2A0H1 diberikan di PMB Rosita kota Pekanbaru sejak 4 November 2024. Pada masa kehamilan dilakukan sebanyak 3 kali kunjungan, nifas 4 kali kunjungan, neonatus 3 kali kunjungan. Selama melakukan asuhan kehamilan pada Ny.R tidak terdapat keluhan dan asuhan yang telah diberikan sesuai dengan kebutuhan kehamilan ibu. Proses persalinan berlangsung secara *Sectio Caesarea* atas indikasi partus tak maju. Bayi lahir tanggal 20 Desember 2024, pukul 18.47 WIB, jenis kelamin laki-laki, berat badan 3.300 gram dan panjang badan 50 cm. Pada kunjungan masa nifas P3A0H2 post SC dengan masalah nyeri pada luka bekas operasi dan ASI belum lancar dilakukan asuhan perawatan luka SC, perawatan payudara, pijat oksitosin dan metode kontrasepsi KB. Pada kunjungan neonatus dilakukan pijat bayi, terjadi peningkatan berat badan bayi sebanyak 500 gram. Diharapkan tenaga kesehatan khususnya bidan dapat melakukan asuhan kebidanan secara berkesinambungan dan berkelanjutan dimulai dari masa kehamilan, persalinan, nifas dan neonatus

ABSTRACT

Midwives are frontline healthcare providers in delivering maternal and child health (MCH) services, and are required to possess high competence as well as the ability to provide comprehensive and continuous care. One approach that supports this is the Continuity of Midwifery Care (CoMC) model, which involves consistent midwifery care throughout pregnancy, childbirth, the postpartum period, newborn care, and family planning services. Comprehensive and continuous care for Mrs. R, G3P2A0H1, was provided at PMB Rosita in Pekanbaru City since 4 November 2024. During the pregnancy period, 3 antenatal visits were conducted, 4 postpartum visits and 3 neonatal visits were also completed. During antenatal care, Mrs. R had no complaints, and the care provided met the needs of her pregnancy. The delivery process was conducted by *Sectio Caesarea* due to Prolonged Labor. The baby was born on December 20, 2024, at 6:47 PM local time, male, weighing 3,300 grams and measuring 50 cm in length. During postpartum visits, Mrs. R P3A0H2 post SC experienced pain at the surgical site and had delayed lactation, care included wound treatment, breast care, oxytocin massage, and counseling on contraceptive methods. Neonatal visits included infant massage, and the baby's weight increased by 500 grams. It is expected that healthcare workers, especially midwives, will continue to provide ongoing and integrated midwifery care starting from pregnancy, childbirth, postpartum, to neonatal care.
