ABSTRAK

AKI di Indonesia jauh lebih tinggi jika dibandingkan dengan beberapa negara di Asia Tenggara, dimana rata-rata AKInya 40-60 per 100.000 kelahiran hidup. Salah satu upaya percepatan penurunan AKI yang dapat dilakukan oleh bidan yaitu metode *Continuity of Midwifery Care*, merupakan model pelayanan berkelanjutan selama kehamilan, persalinan, nifas dan neonatus. Studi kasus ini bertujuan untuk memberikan asuhan kebidanan yang menyeluruh dan berkesinambungan dimulai sejak hamil, bersalin, nifas serta KB dan neonatus. Asuhan dilakukan dari bulan Oktober 2024 - Januari 2025 pada Ny.M G1P0A0H0 di Klinik Pratama Afiyah kota Pekanbaru, dengan 3 kali asuhan kehamilan, asuhan persalinan, 4 kali asuhan nifas dan 3 kali asuhan neonatus. Keluhan ibu pada usia kehamilan 34-35 minggu yaitu kram perut bagian bawah. Asuhan yang diberikan yaitu dengan memberikan senam hamil. Proses persalinan berlangsung secara *Sectio Caesarea* atas indikasi tidak ada kemajuan penurunan kepala. Bayi lahir, jenis kelamin perempuan, berat badan 2.700 gram dan panjang badan 49 cm. Pada masa nifas ditemukan masalah nyeri pada luka bekas operasi. Asuhan yang diberikan yaitu, perawatan luka operasi, skrining *Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale* (EPDS), dan konseling KB. Ibu menjadi akseptor AKDR (Alat Kontrasepsi Dalam Rahim). Pada masa neonatus diberikan asuhan perawatan tali pusat, pijat bayi. Terjadi peningkatan berat badan bayi 500 gram selama 20 hari. Diharapkan kepada bidan sebagai tenaga kesehatan tetap mempertahankan pemberian pelayanan kebidanan secara komprehensif dan berkesinambungan terutama asuhan ibu hamil, bersalin, nifas dan neonatus.

ABSTRACT

The maternal mortality rate in Indonesia is much higher compared to several countries in Southeast Asia, where the average maternal mortality rate is 40-60 per 100,000 live births. One of the effort to accelerate the reduction of MMR is carried out by midwives using the Continuity of Midwifery Care method, which is a midwifery service through a continuous service model during pregnancy, childbirth, postpartum and neonatal. Case study report aims to provide comprehensive and continuous midwifery care starting from pregnancy, childbirth, postpartum and family planning and neonates carried out from October 2024 - January 2025 on Mrs.M GIP0A0H0 at Clinic Pratama Afiyah Pekanbaru city, with 3 pregnancy care, birth care, 4 postpartum care and 3 neonate care. The mother's 34-35 week complaint lower stomach cramps, the care given is by giving pregnancy exercise. The delivery process took place by Sectio Caesarea on the indication no progress in lowering the head. The baby spontan, female gender, weight 2,700 grams and length 49 cm. In the postpartum period, there was a problem of pain in the surgical wound, the care given was surgical wound care, as well as screening the Edinburgh Postnatal Depression Scale (EPDS), providing family planning counseling and the mother chose to become a 3-month injectable family planning acceptor. In the neonate period, baby massage care was given, there was an increase. In baby weight of 500 grams for 20 days. It is expected that midwives as health workers continue to maintain the provision of
